APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN THE MEMBERSHIP OF SUBSIDIARY BODIES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

UNITED NATIONS STAFF PENSION COMMITTEE

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Babooram RAMBISOON (Trinidad and Tobago)

1. At its 1428th meeting, held on 7 October 1971, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/1373) concerning the vacancy occurring in the membership of the United Nations Staff Pension Committee as a result of the resignation of Mr. John I.M. Rhodes with effect from 22 September 1971.
2. The members of the Fifth Committee were invited to suggest the names of persons who might be recommended to the General Assembly for appointment to the United Nations Staff Pension Committee in accordance with the provisions of rules 156 and 157 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly. The Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland nominated Miss Kathleen Whalley for election to the United Nations Staff Pension Committee for the unexpired portion of Mr. Rhodes' term of office, that is, until 31 December 1973 (A/C.5/1373).
3. The Fifth Committee voted by secret ballot to decide on its recommendation. The result of the voting was as follows:

4. Miss Whalley (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland), having received the required majority, was declared recommended for appointment as a member of the United Nations Staff Pension Committee to serve until 31 December 1973.
