**JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ
ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS
BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF THE FIJI ISLANDS AND
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

The Republic of the Fiji Islands and the Republic of Armenia,

Desirous of promoting relations of friendship and cooperation in the political, economic, cultural, humanitarian and other mutual cooperation fields,

Believing in developing these essential relations on the basis of the purposes and principles of the Charter of the United Nations, and the norms of international law,


Convinced that the establishment of diplomatic relations corresponds with the national interests of both countries and will contribute to the consolidation of the cooperation and peace in the world,

Have agreed to establish diplomatic relations at Ambassadorial level as of the date of the signature of this Joint Communiqué, in accordance with the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of April 18, 1961.

In witness thereof, the undersigned representatives, duly authorized by their respective Governments, have signed this Joint Communiqué in two originals in English and Armenian languages, both texts being equally authentic.

Done in Beijing this 7th day of June, 2010.
