

## PROVISIONAL AGENDA OF THE THIRD REGULAR SESSION

## ITEMS PROPOSED BY CHILE

Note by the Secretary-General

The following letter has been received from the Permanent Representative of Chile to the United Nations:

New York, 27 May 1948

In accordance with rule 13 of the Rules of Procedure of the General Assembly, I have the honour to inform you that the Government of Chile requests the inclusion of the following items in the provisional agenda of the third regular session of the General Assembly to be held next September:

1. Violation by the Soviet Union of fundamental human rights in preventing the Russian wives of foreign nationals from leaving the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics either in company with their husbands or in order to rejoin them, action which could impair friendly relations among nations and violate the principles of the Charter. This is in accordance with Article 14 of the United Nations Charter.
2. Violation by the Soviet Union of fundamental human rights, traditional diplomatic practices and other principles of the Charter, in refusing to allow a member of the family of the Ex-Ambassador of Chile to the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics to leave that country in company with the Ambassador. This is in accordance with Article 14 of the United Nations Charter.
