ACTION TAKEN IN PURSUANCE OF THE AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE UNITED NATIONS AND THE SPECIALIZED AGENCIES

Note by the Secretary-General

1. The Economic and Social Council, at its 331st meeting on 9 August 1949, adopted resolution 259(IX) C which reads as follows:

"The Economic and Social Council,

"Noting the instruction in General Assembly resolution 50(I) that the Council report to the General Assembly on the question of collaboration among the specialized agencies and the organs of the United Nations in carrying out the terms of the agreements between the United Nations and the specialized agencies,

"Considering that progress is being achieved in collaboration among the United Nations and the specialized agencies within the existing framework of agreements with the specialized agencies and the Charter of the United Nations,

"Recommends to the General Assembly that no measures for revision of these agreements be taken at this time by the Council or the General Assembly;

"Transmits to the General Assembly a report** on action taken in pursuance of the agreements between the United Nations and the specialized agencies; and

"Requests the Secretary-General to submit a summary report to the fourth session of the General Assembly, giving an illustrative account of the more important concrete results achieved through co-operation with the specialized agencies on questions of substance."

2. In accordance with the terms of the last paragraph of the above resolution, the Secretary-General is preparing the summary report requested, which will be presented to the Assembly in due course.
