**NOTE VERBALE DATED 10 FEBRUARY 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT  
MISSION OF YUGOSLAVIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED  
TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL**

The Permanent Mission of the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to his Note No. SCPC/2/92/(1) of 28 January 1992, has the honour to inform that, following the policy of non-interference in internal affairs of other countries and export ban on weapons and military equipment to crisis and war stricken areas, Yugoslavia has not supplied weapons and military equipment to Somalia since the conflict broke out in that country.

Yugoslavia fully complies with the decision of the Security Council and will strictly abide by the arms and military equipment embargo for Somalia pursuant to Security Council resolution 733 (1991).
