Note by the Secretary-General

Addendum

1. In accordance with relevant Economic and Social Council resolutions, and, in particular resolution 1986/35, the Commission on Human Rights, at its forty-eighth session, is called upon to elect half of the Sub-Commission membership and the corresponding alternates, if any, in accordance with the following pattern: four members from African States; two members from Asian States; two members from Eastern European States; two members from Latin American States and three members from Western European and other States.
2. The Secretary-General, in documents E/CN.4/1992/56 and Add.1-3, informed the Commission of the nominations of candidates and alternates for election to the Sub-Commission received as at 6 February 1992. Those documents also contained the biographical data of candidates and alternates which had been received.
3. Additional nominations and biographical data have been received since 6 February 1992.
