REVIEW OF EXTRABUDGETARY FUNDS

Note by the Executive Secretary

I. SPECIAL VOLUNTARY FUND TO SUPPORT THE PARTICIPATION OF DEVELOPING COUNTRIES

1. The current state of pledges and receipts for the special voluntary fund is shown in table 1. New elements since the fourth session of the Committee are the payment by Spain and the indications of forthcoming contributions from Denmark, France and Sweden, to be confirmed during the current session. Some other pledges may be announced.
2. The state of the fund has permitted the usual arrangements to be made for supporting developing country participation in the current session.
3. The additional funding needed to finance participation in the resumed fifth session, over and above the amounts already pledged, is of the order of US\$ 250,000.
4. The secretariat has been informed that Australia has contributed US\$ 80,840 to the South Pacific Regional Environment Programme (SPREP) since February 1991 to assist developing countries of that region to participate in the negotiations.

II. TRUST FUND FOR THE NEGOTIATING PROCESS

5. Table 2 shows the state of the trust fund for the negotiating process.
