Note by the Secretary-General

Addendum

1. In accordance with relevant Economic and Social Council resolutions, and, in particular resolution 1986/35, the Commission on Human Rights, at its forty-eighth session, is called upon to elect half of the Sub-Commission membership and the corresponding alternates, if any, in accordance with the following pattern: four members from African States; two members from Asian States; two members from Eastern European States; two members from Latin American States and three members from Western European and other States.
2. The Secretary-General, in documents E/CN.4/1992/56 and Add.1-4, informed the Commission of the nominations of candidates and alternates for election to the Sub-Commission received as at 11 February 1992. Those documents also contained the biographical data of candidates and alternates which had been received.
3. Additional nominations and biographical data have been received since 11 February 1992.
