Situation of human rights in southern Lebanon

Report of the Secretary-General

1. At its forty-seventh session the Commission on Human Rights adopted resolution 1991/66, entitled "Situation of human rights in southern Lebanon". In paragraph 5 of the resolution, the Commission requested the Secretary-General (a) to bring the resolution to the attention of the Government of Israel and to invite it to provide information concerning the extent of its implementation thereof and (b) to report to the General Assembly at its forty-sixth session and to the Commission on Human Rights at its forty-eighth session on the results of his efforts in that regard.
2. In accordance with this request, the Secretary-General on 27 June 1991 addressed a note verbale to the Minister for Foreign Affairs of the State of Israel requesting information concerning the extent of the implementation of the resolution.
3. No reply had been received at the time of the preparation of the present report.
