Supplemental Information

1. The Chief of Staff of UNTSO has reported that during the period from 11 August 1967, the date of the last Supplemental Information from the Secretary-General (S/7930/Add.28), until 0300 hours GMT on 24 August, the situation in general remained quiet in both the Israel-Syria sector in the Suez sector. However, the Chief of Staff reported on 23 August 1967 that the demolition of buildings comprising the Syrian village of Kafr El Maa, which lies east of the cease-fire line within the buffer zone, was taking place despite protests lodged with the Senior Liaison Officer of the Israel Defence Forces, and that the Chief of Staff considers this action to be a breach of the cease-fire.
2. Pursuant to paragraph 8 of my report on the observation of the cease-fire in the Suez Canal sector, covering the period from 11 July to 5 August 1967 (S/8053/Add.1), on 18 August 1967 I undertook the recruitment of twenty-one additional observers, with instructions that they proceed to the area without delay. The first group of these observers is due to arrive in the area on 25 August 1967.
