SECRETARY-GENERAL'S BULLETIN

SUBJECT: Travel Subsistence Allowance - Staff Rule 107.15

As a result of changes in the organizational structure of the Secretariat, Staff Rule 107.15 is revised with effect from 1 January 1955.

Rule 107.15

Travel Subsistence Allowance

(a) Except during travel by sea, and subject to reduction under Rule 107.17 and to the application of a special rate under Rule 107.16, a staff member when authorized to travel at United Nations expense, shall receive the appropriate daily subsistence allowance as specified hereunder:

Applicable to	Group 1	Group 2	Group 3
Under-Secretaries and officials of equivalent rank	\$20.00	\$16.00	Special Rates
Staff members in the level of Second Officer and above	12.50	10.00	
Staff members below the level of Second Officer	10.00	8.00	

Group 1 rates shall apply for all areas, other than those which are designated as belonging to Groups 2 or 3.

Group 2 rates shall apply in the case of stop-overs of more than 24 hours in areas of relatively lower subsistence cost, as designated by the Secretary-General from time to time by administrative instruction or other appropriate means.

Group 3 rates, which shall be established by the Secretary-General as necessary and notified by administrative instruction or other appropriate means, shall
