SECRETARY-GENERAL'S BULLETIN

To: Members of the staff

Subject: ORGANIZATION OF THE SECRETARIAT

1. With effect from 29 April 1958 responsibility at present exercised by Mr. Philippe de Seynes, Under-Secretary for Economic and Social Affairs, with regard to the functions and staff of the Division of Narcotic Drugs and with regard to the joint Secretariat of the Permanent Central Opium Board and the Drug Supervisory Body, will be transferred to Sir Humphrey Trevelyan, Under-Secretary in charge of Special Political Affairs.
2. After the date of transfer, the present arrangements for liaison between the Division of Narcotic Drugs and departments and offices at Headquarters, and for the provision of administrative support and services, will continue unchanged, in conformity, so far as they relate to the United Nations Office at Geneva, with SGB/82/Rev.2 issued on 9 December 1957.
3. Routine matters arising at Headquarters concerning the Division of Narcotic Drugs should continue to be referred to the Liaison Officer, Mr. Messing-Mierzejewski, Room 2949A, Ext. 2222.
