
CO-ORDINATION OF THE ACTIVITIES OF THE UNITED NATIONS AND THE
SPECIALIZED AGENCIES IN THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL FIELDS

DRAFT RESOLUTION II* (FIRST PARAGRAPHS)

THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL,

TAKING NOTE of the Articles of the Agreements with the specialized agencies providing for the submission of reports to the United Nations, and the resolution of the General Assembly calling upon the specialized agencies to present each year to the Session of the Economic and Social Council preceding the opening of the Regular Session of the General Assembly their reports on past activities, and their programmes of operation;

REQUESTS the specialized agencies to submit to the Secretary-General not later than 15 May of each year such reports as appropriate under the terms of their respective agreements with the United Nations containing:

1. Information relating to the organization of the agency such as membership, an organization chart of the Secretariat, a list of committees and a summary of their functions;
2. An account of the activities of the agency for the past year including (a) conferences and meetings held; (b) actions taken, such as conventions or regulations adopted, recommendations to Governments, expert assistance rendered Governments, studies made and publications issued, noting particularly actions taken pursuant to recommendations of the General Assembly and the Economic and Social Council; (c) relations with the United Nations and its various organs, matters referred by the agency to the United Nations, participating in United Nations meetings, and co-operative projects; (d) relations with other specialized agencies.
