CORRIGENDUM TO DOCUMENT E/AC.14/3

Pages 3 and 4. The record of the first part of the French representative's speech should read as follows:

"Mr. BAUMGARTNER, speaking on behalf of his government, stated his approval of the work performed by the Commission in presenting a clear and definite picture of the reconstruction accomplished, and the plans for future reconstruction in each country. As regards the recommendation concerning the Economic Commission for Europe, he made two reservations: one, that the Economic Commission should be composed of all the European Members of the United Nations, because of their direct interest in the problem; and second, as had been suggested by the representative of Poland on the Sub-Commission, that it was essential to direct effort first of all toward the solution of the most urgent and difficult problems and the reconstruction of the most heavily devastated areas.

Although he knew the other recommendations in the Report must have seemed vague to those facing a difficult situation, he felt that it was necessary to reach agreement first on direction of the programme, for instance about international trade. On the whole, he considered that"
