REPRESENTATION BY SOUTHERN YEMEN

The following communication, dated 25 April 1968, from the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of Southern Yemen to the Secretary-General of the United Nations is submitted to the Committee on Contributions for consideration:

"The Minister of Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of Southern Yemen presents his compliments to His Excellency the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to refer to His Excellency's note (FI 312/1 1966) of 5 April 1968, and requests that the People's Republic of Southern Yemen, due to the critical financial and economical difficulties facing the newly born Republic, be exempted by the Committee on Contributions in its next session, scheduled to open in New York on 1 May 1968, from paying this year's contribution.

"The Minister of Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of Southern Yemen avails himself of this opportunity to renew to His Excellency the Secretary-General of the United Nations the assurance of his highest consideration."
