LETTER DATED 5 AUGUST 1966 FROM MR. MAURICE VIAUD,  
MEMBER OF THE COMMITTEE ON CONTRIBUTIONS, ADDRESSED  
TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE UNITED NATIONS
