ASSESSMENT OF HUNGARY

The following communication has been addressed to the Chairman of the Committee on Contributions by the Permanent Representative of the Hungarian People's Republic to the United Nations:

31 March 1961

"The Permanent Representative of the Hungarian People's Republic to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Chairman of the Committee on Contributions and has the honour to transmit herewith data concerning the national income of the Hungarian People's Republic for consideration by the Committee on Contributions at its forthcoming session.

"Comparable data on the national income of Hungary in the years 1957, 1958 and 1959 indicate that the average national income in these years was 109,511 million forints corresponding to 4,664 million US dollars at the exchange rate of \$1 = 23.48 forints.

"Taking the data of the population census of 1 January 1960 as a basis, the average per capita national income figures for the same period are 10,976 forints and 467.46 US dollars respectively.

"As regards other factors concerning Hungary's capacity to contribute to the United Nations budget, the Permanent Representative of the Hungarian People's Republic to the United Nations wishes to make further observations at a later date.

"The Permanent Representative of the Hungarian People's Republic to the United Nations avails himself of this opportunity to renew to the Chairman of the Committee on Contributions the assurances of his highest consideration."
