STATISTICS OF THE CENTRALLY PLANNED ECONOMIES

Hungary

The following communication has been addressed to the Chairman of the Committee on Contributions by the Permanent Representative of Hungary to the United Nations:

22 May 1961

"I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated 19 May 1961, requesting data on the volume of certain types of services considered as non-productive and therefore excluded from the estimate of Hungary's national income.

"According to calculations based on figures in the national budget the volume of these types of services in 1957, 1958 and 1959 did not exceed 5 per cent of the average national income for that period earlier indicated to you in Note No. 51 of 31 March 1961.

"May I express, on behalf of the Hungarian Government, my earnest hope that due account will be taken by the Committee on Contributions of this additional information as well."
