LETTER DATED 24 APRIL 1970 FROM MR. JEAN K. NGUZA, DEPUTY PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF THE DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF THE CONGO TO THE UNITED NATIONS' ADDRESSED TO THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE ON CONTRIBUTIONS
