ECONOMIC AND EMPLOYMENT COMMISSION

THE FUTURE ORGANIZATION AND TERMS OF REFERENCE OF THE ECONOMIC
AND EMPLOYMENT COMMISSION AND ITS SUB-COMMISSIONS

Additional communication received from a Member Government: Union of Burma: The Government of the Union of Burma are of the view that if the Economic and Employment Commission is to fulfil effectively the purposes for which it was established it would be necessary to appoint sub-commissions on a regional basis. Each of the regional sub-commissions would be expected to study its own problems and to make its own recommendations to the Economic and Employment Commission. The sub-commissions should be composed entirely of experts to be nominated by the Governments concerned.

Pending any change in the composition of the Economic and Employment Commission the Government of the Union of Burma would suggest that observers be sent by the Commission to the different regions to conduct investigations so that the Commission may know exactly how much and in what direction each region is in need of help especially with regard to the problem of reconstruction of devastated areas.
