Guatemala: draft resolution

The Fourth Committee

Resolves to establish a sub-committee consisting of the representatives
of

1. To study, in the light of the Special Committee's Report and Fourth Committee's discussions, and to define in a draft resolution the basic and general factors to be taken into account in deciding whether or not a territory has attained a full measure of self-government;
2. To consider the advisability of establishing a committee to -
 - (a) study these factors in greater detail;
 - (b) analyse the cases of territories which in the opinion of certain administering Powers have attained a full measure of self-government; and
 - (c) recommend the appropriate resolutions to the General Assembly at its next session.
3. To submit its report to the Committee at the present session.
