Assumption by the United Nations of administrative and  
financial responsibilities arising out of the Protocol

Note by the Secretary-General

The following draft resolution, designed for inclusion in the Final Act, is submitted for the consideration of the Conference:

The Conference,

Having regard to the functions and responsibilities exercised by the United Nations in the international control of narcotic drugs, and

Considering that the arrangements established in the Protocol fall within the framework of the United Nations,

1. Invites the Economic and Social Council to recommend to the General Assembly:
  - (i) To approve the assumption of the functions and responsibilities attributed by the Protocol to organs of the United Nations, and
  - (ii) To include the Protocol among the international instruments relating to the control of narcotic drugs for the purpose of assessment, in accordance with resolution 455 (V) of the General Assembly, to Parties non-members of the United Nations of their fair share of the expenses borne by the United Nations in connexion with those instruments, and
2. Invites the Economic and Social Council to include this item on the provisional agenda of the eighth session of the General Assembly.
