The allocation of shares in the world opium production
as provided for in the draft interim agreement

Note by the Secretariat

1. For the information of members of the Conference, in connexion with the Final Act, it is recalled that provision was made for the allocations of shares in the world opium production in annex "B" of the draft of the proposed interim agreement to limit the production of opium to medical and scientific needs (E/CN.7/199, 13 July 1950, p. 59-61). The annex formed an integral part of the interim agreement itself, and its provisions would thus have been binding upon parties thereto.

2. The allocations were made by annex "B" in the following manner:
