Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 33rd and 34th meetings, on 27 and 29 March 2018, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement submitted by the Secretary-General on the programme budget implications of draft resolution [A/72/L.40](#) ([A/C.5/72/22](#)) and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions ([A/72/7/Add.46](#)). The statements and comments made in the course of the Fifth Committee's consideration of this question are reflected in the relevant summary records.¹

2. At its 34th meeting, the Committee had before it a draft decision submitted by the Chair of the Committee on the basis of informal consultations coordinated by the representative of Saudi Arabia ([A/C.5/72/L.27](#)). At the same meeting, the Committee adopted draft decision [A/C.5/72/L.27](#) without a vote (see para. 3).

Decision of the Fifth Committee

3. The Fifth Committee, having considered the statement of programme budget implications submitted by the Secretary-General² and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,³ decides to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution [A/72/L.40](#), resources amounting to \$49,800 would be required under section 2, General Assembly and Economic and Social Council affairs and conference management, and \$9,900 under

section 28, Public information, of the programme budget for the biennium 2018–2019. Efforts will be made to absorb the estimated additional requirements of \$59,700 within the programme budget for the biennium 2018–2019, and the additional expenditures will be reported in the relevant performance report for the same biennium.
