ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA

The agenda was adopted.

APPLICATION OF TURKMENISTAN FOR ADMISSION TO MEMBERSHIP IN THE UNITED NATIONS
(S/23489 and Corr.1)

The CHAIRMAN said that, at the 3048th meeting of the Security Council, held on 5 February 1992, the President of the Council had decided to refer to the Committee the application of Turkmenistan for admission to membership in the United Nations, contained in the letter dated 20 January 1992 from the President of Turkmenistan addressed to the Secretary-General (S/23489 and Corr.1), for examination and report to the Council.

The Secretariat had prepared a draft report, which had been distributed to Committee members, containing a draft resolution whose adoption the Committee would recommend to the Council. As Turkmenistan had submitted its application while the forty-sixth session of the General Assembly was suspended, the Committee recommended that the Council should apply the last paragraph of rule 60 of its provisional rules of procedure.

If he heard no objection, he would take it that the Committee wished to adopt the draft report.

It was so decided.

The CHAIRMAN informed the Committee that the Council would consider the Committee's report on a date to be set in the course of Council consultations.

The meeting rose at 10.50 a.m.
