LETTER DATED 10 AUGUST 1992 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I.  
OF TURKEY TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT  
OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

The situation in Bosnia and Herzegovina has reached alarming proportions. The world is witnessing blatant violations of human rights that threaten international peace and security.

Bosnia and Herzegovina is a Member of the United Nations whose sovereignty and territorial integrity have been grossly violated in total disregard of international law, the Charter of the United Nations and the resolutions of the Security Council.

The Government of Turkey requests that the Security Council hold an urgent meeting with a formal debate to consider the situation in Bosnia and Herzegovina and take appropriate measures as provided in Chapter VII of the Charter to alleviate the plight of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

I should be grateful if you could circulate this letter as a document of the Security Council.
