## GENERAL AND COMPLETE DISARMAMENT: NAVAL ARMAMENTS AND DISARMAMENT

Bulgaria, German Democratic Republic, Lao People's Democratic  
Republic : draft resolutionConfidence-building measures at seaThe General Assembly,Bearing in mind the report of the Disarmament Commission, 1/Noting the significance of confidence-building measures for creating favourable conditions for progress in the field of disarmament and for ensuring the security of maritime communication in peacetime,Considering that at the present stage confidence-building measures of various kinds, both in the global and in the regional context, would be more amenable to further consideration and possible negotiations in appropriate forums,

1. Requests the Disarmament Commission to continue at its 1988 substantive session the consideration of the question of naval armaments and disarmament, with a view to facilitating the identification of possible measures in the field of naval arms limitation and disarmament, as well as confidence-building measures, taking into account the security interests of all States, and to submit a report on the subject, including findings and recommendations, as appropriate, to the General Assembly at its forty-third session;

Requests further the Disarmament Commission, as part of the consideration of the question of naval armaments and disarmament, to devote more attention to the identification, at an early stage, of specific confidence-building measures at sea which might be generally acceptable and which could become subject to consultations and eventual negotiations.
