INTRODUCTORY NOTE

These Official Records include the corrections to the provisional summary records that were requested by the delegations and such drafting and editorial modifications as were considered necessary.

Symbols of United Nations documents are composed of capital letters combined with figures. Occurrence of such a symbol indicates a reference to a United Nations document. Symbols referring to resolutions of the General Assembly consist of an arabic numeral indicating the number of the resolution and a roman numeral indicating the number of the session. The resolutions for each session are printed in a separate volume as a supplement to the *Official Records* of the relevant session of the General Assembly.

Certain documents relating to each agenda item are published as annexes. These annexes are printed in separate fascicules, one to each agenda item.

A check list of documents relating to the agenda of the ninth session of the General Assembly, indicating where they can be found, is contained in the prefatory fascicule to the plenary meetings of the General Assembly.
