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## GENERALIZED SYSTEM OF PREFERENCES

Replies received from preference-giving countries: Norway

Note by the UNCTAD secretariat

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### Introduction

1. In response to the note of the Secretary-General of UNCTAD dated 23 November 1973 requesting preference-giving countries to provide information on the operation of their respective schemes of generalized preferences, the Government of Norway has provided information on various categories of imports of products covered by its scheme for the period 1987-1990. 1/ A summary of this information is given below and the data on Norwegian imports from beneficiaries are presented in tables 1 and 2 of the annex to this note. 2/

#### I. Imports by Norway from beneficiary suppliers in 1987, 1988, 1989 and 1990

2. As may be seen from table 1B, Norway registered imports from 120, 141, 116 and 109 beneficiaries in 1987, 1988, 1989 and 1990, respectively. Fifteen of the beneficiaries in 1987, 18 in 1988, 25 in 1989 and 20 in 1990 did not supply any dutiable product to Norway and therefore could not avail themselves of advantages under the scheme. One of the beneficiaries in 1987, three in 1988, two in 1989 and four in 1990 could not claim preferential treatment because their exports were not covered by the scheme. Finally, 54 beneficiaries in 1987, 59 in 1988, 31 in 1989 and 34 in 1990 failed to receive preferential treatment in those years, although some of their exports were covered by the scheme. One reason may have been non-compliance with rules of origin. Often, however, beneficiary exporters do not claim GSP treatment. Thus, 50 beneficiaries actually received GSP treatment in 1987, 61 in 1988, 58 in 1989 and 51 in 1990.

3. Total Norwegian imports from all beneficiaries in 1987, 1988, 1989 and 1990, as shown in table 1A, amounted to \$1.824 billion, \$3.224 billion, \$4.585 billion and \$3.877 billion, respectively. Dutiable imports accounted for \$755 million in 1987, \$767 million in 1988, \$729 million in 1989, \$1.105 billion in 1990 or 41.4 per cent, 23.8 per cent, 15.9 per cent and 28.5 per cent of the value of total imports of each year, respectively. Of these imports, 64 per cent or \$483 million were covered by the scheme in 1987, 61 per cent or \$469 million in 1988, 59.9 per cent or \$437 million in 1989 and 67.6 per cent or \$747 million in 1990. The bulk of these covered imports (\$389 million or 80.5 per cent in 1987, \$381 million or 81.2 per cent in 1988, \$348 million or 79.6 per cent in 1989 and \$646 million or 86.5 per cent in 1990) consisted of industrial products and raw materials in HS chapters 25-97. Agricultural products in HS chapters 1-24 accounted for the remaining \$94 million, \$88 million, \$89 million and \$100 million, respectively, in each year. Those imports which actually received preferential treatment amounted to \$208 million in 1987 of which \$36 million (17.3 per cent) were agricultural products and \$172 million (82.7 per cent) were industrial products. In 1988, preferential imports amounted to \$227 million of which \$35 million were agricultural products (15.4 per cent) and \$192 million (84.6 per cent) were industrial products. In 1989, preferential imports amounted to \$210 million of which \$33 million (15.7 per cent) were agricultural products and \$177 million (84.3 per cent) were industrial products. In 1990 preferential imports amounted to \$269 million of which \$36 million (13.4 per cent) were agricultural products and \$233 million (86.6 per cent) were industrial products.

4. The overall rate of utilization of the Norwegian scheme as measured by the ratio of preferential imports to imports covered by Norway, was 43 per cent in 1987, 48.4 per cent in 1988, 48.1 per cent in 1989 and 36 per cent in 1990. The utilization rate of agricultural products and industrial products amounted, respectively, to 38.3 per cent and 44.2 per cent in 1987, 39.3 per cent and 50.4 per cent in 1988, 37.4 per cent and 50.8 per cent in 1989 and 35.5 per cent and 36.1 per cent in 1990. However, as may be seen from table 1B, these utilization rates varied widely from beneficiary to beneficiary.

5. Eleven major suppliers accounted for \$396 million or 82 per cent of all imports covered by the Norwegian scheme in 1987 and for \$171 million or 82.3 per cent of the total value of imports which actually received preferences. In 1988 and 1989, twelve major suppliers accounted for \$380 million and \$356 million or 81 per cent and 81.5 per cent of all imports covered by the scheme. Imports which actually received preferences for the two years amounted to \$195 million and \$178 million or 85.9 per cent and 84.8 per cent of the total imports which received preferences respectively. In 1990, 11 major suppliers accounted for \$599 million or 80.2 per cent of all imports covered by the scheme and for \$221 million or 82.2 per cent of the total value of imports which actually received preferences. By order of the relative value of covered imports entering Norway in 1990, the major suppliers were: Republic of Korea, China, Panama, Hong Kong, Singapore, the former Yugoslavia, Israel, Turkey, Malaysia, Thailand and India. Elsewhere, even though the covered exports of Argentina, Brazil and Morocco increased or remained more or less the same as before, they ceased to be major suppliers in 1990, while Panama emerged as a major supplier in 1990.

6. Dutiable Norwegian imports from 30 supplying least developed countries (LDCs) <sup>3/</sup> in 1987, 36 in 1988, 26 in 1989 and 25 in 1990 attained a value of \$11 million for each of the first three years rising to \$18 million for the last year. Since all imported products from LDCs are covered by the Norwegian scheme, covered imports are the same as dutiable imports. <sup>4/</sup> Of the covered imports, 15.4 per cent or \$1,694 thousand, 15.9 per cent or \$1,742 thousand, 17.3 per cent or \$1,883 thousand and 25.7 per cent or \$4,483 thousand received preferential treatment in 1987, 1988, 1989 and 1990, respectively. Seven of these LDCs received preferential treatment in 1987, eight in 1988, seven in 1989 and nine in 1990. Bangladesh (\$2,865 thousand), Nepal (\$592 thousand), Lao People's Democratic Republic (\$506 thousand) and Botswana (\$328 thousand) accounted for 95.7 per cent of total preferential imports in 1990.

7. Norwegian imports of products covered by the scheme from Mediterranean (MED) and ACP countries, which enjoy special preferences in the EEC market, amounted to \$83 million and \$5 million in 1990, respectively. The value of imports from the two sources receiving preferential treatment in 1990 amounted to \$27 million and \$2 million, respectively. Thus, in 1990, these two groups of countries supplied 11.8 per cent of products eligible for preferential treatment under the scheme and 10.8 per cent of total imports which actually received preferential treatment.

II. Imports of major products under the Norwegian scheme  
in 1990 and major suppliers

8. Table 2 of the annex shows the value of Norwegian imports in 1990 of major products covered by its scheme from all beneficiary suppliers and individual major suppliers as well as the value of imports of these products which effectively received preferential treatment. Imports from beneficiaries of major products, defined at the Norwegian tariff line level, covered by the scheme in 1990, were recorded under 189 tariff lines of which 16 items were agricultural products and the remaining 173 items were industrial products. Imports of these major products from beneficiaries amounted to \$596 million or 79.8 per cent of the total imports covered (\$747 million) in 1990. Of these imports, 34.9 per cent received preferential treatment.

9. Some 21 major products, the covered imports of which were valued at \$4 million or more, accounted for 55.9 per cent of the covered imports of the 189 major products in 1990. They were, by order of importance of value as follows (value of covered imports expressed in \$ million): Norwegian tariff line 89.05.2000 Floating or submersible drilling or production platforms (171.4); tariff line 08.05.1000 Oranges (17.5); tariff line 84.73.3000 Parts and accessories of machines under heading No. 84.71 (15.4); tariff line 08.08.1090 Apples from 16 March to 31 July (13.7); tariff line 08.05.2000 Mandarins... clementines... - 2/ Information received from Norway on trade effects of its scheme for the years 1980, 1981, 1983, 1984 and 1985 is contained in documents TD/B/C.5/PREF/19, 23 and 35.
- 3/ Norway grants preferences to all LDCs recognized by the United Nations General Assembly. In the present analysis only actual LDCs beneficiaries (up to 1990) have been taken into account. Therefore imports from Cambodia, Madagascar, Solomon Islands, Zambia and Zaire are not included in imports from LDCs into Norway.
- 4/ However, there is a slight discrepancy between dutiable and covered imports in 1990.
