In accordance with Article 4 of the Charter of the United Nations and in compliance with rule 58 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council and rule 134 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, I have the honour, on behalf of the Czech Republic and in my capacity as Prime Minister of the Czech Republic, to inform you that the Czech Republic herewith applies for membership in the United Nations.

I should accordingly be grateful if you would arrange for this application to be placed before the Security Council and the General Assembly at their next meetings.

As stated in a formal declaration attached to this application, the Czech Republic is willing to accept and carry out the obligations contained in the Charter of the United Nations.
