## II - ANNOTATIONS TO THE PROVISIONAL AGENDA

Item 1:        Opening of the Conference

The Conference will be opened by the Secretary-General of UNCTAD or his representative on 8 March 1993.

Item 3:        Adoption of the rules of procedure

The provisional rules of procedure, as adopted by the United Nations Conference on Olive Oil, 1986, are contained in TD/OLIVE OIL.9/2.

Item 4:        Election of officers

Rule 6 of the provisional rules of procedure provides that the Conference shall elect a President and two Vice-Presidents.

Item 5:        Credentials of representatives

Rule 3 of the provisional rules of procedure provides that the credentials of representatives, alternate representatives and advisers shall be submitted to the Secretary-General of UNCTAD, if possible not later than 24 hours after the opening of the Conference. Rule 4 provides that a Credentials Committee, consisting of five members appointed by the Conference on the proposal of the President, shall examine and report on the credentials of representatives.

Item 6:        Establishment of an Executive Committee and of other committees as required

Rule 47 of the provisional rules of procedure provides that the Conference may establish such committees, sub-committees and working parties as may be necessary for the work of the Conference. It is proposed in this connection that the Conference should establish an Executive Committee of the whole to deal with items 7 and 8 of the provisional agenda in closed meetings. It is further proposed that the Executive Committee should in turn establish a legal drafting committee.

Item 7:        Preparation of a Protocol extending the International Agreement on Olive Oil and Table Olives, 1986, with amendments

The Conference will have before it a draft Protocol extending the International Agreement on Olive Oil and Table Olives, 1986, with amendments (TD/OLIVE OIL.9/R.1). A note on international cooperation on olive oil and table olives prepared by the UNCTAD secretariat, in cooperation with the Executive Secretariat of the International Olive Oil Council, will be available to the Conference in TD/OLIVE OIL.9/3.
