ORGANIZATION OF WORK OF THE THIRD COMMITTEE

Note by the Secretariat

Allocation of items

1. The agenda items allocated by the General Assembly to the Third Committee are listed in the letter dated 23 September 1994 from the President of the Assembly to the Chairman of the Third Committee (A/C.3/49/1). Background information on those items may be found in the annotations to the agenda (A/49/100). A list of documents submitted under the various agenda items allocated to the Third Committee is set out in an addendum to the present document (A/C.3/49/L.1/Add.1*).

Programme of work

2. The suggested programme of work annexed to the present document has been prepared bearing in mind paragraph (b) of rule 99 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, General Assembly resolution 45/175 of 18 December 1990 on the rationalization of the work of the Third Committee and General Assembly decision 48/431 of 20 December 1993 on the organization of work of the Third Committee and biennial programme of work of the Committee for 1994-1995. Other relevant resolutions and decisions adopted by the Assembly, the organizational arrangements agreed upon by the Assembly at the outset of its current session (A/49/250) and the availability of documentation as well as past experience in the utilization of conference services have also been taken into account.

Length of statements

3. In view of the limited number of meetings available to the Committee during the session, it is suggested that the time-limit for statements be set at 10 minutes, with the exception of statements being made by the spokesmen of groups of delegations, which would be set at 15 minutes.

Conference facilities and meeting arrangements

4. Taking into account the availability of conference services for the Main Committees of the General Assembly, an average of six formal meetings a week have been scheduled for the Third Committee. Unless otherwise specified, meetings will be held at 10 a.m. and 3 p.m. In this connection, the General Assembly has reminded delegations that punctuality is of the utmost importance in the interest of ensuring an effective and orderly completion of work and achieving necessary economies for the United Nations. As decided by the General Assembly, the requirement of the presence of at least one quarter of the members of the Third Committee to declare a meeting open and permit the debate to proceed has been waived.

Working Group of the Third Committee

5. The Committee is reminded that, at its 59th meeting during the forty-eighth session of the General Assembly, on 15 September 1994, the Third Committee decided that the work of the Working Group should continue during the forty-ninth session under agenda item 100 (b). In order to permit full participation of all representatives, meetings of the Working Group will, to the maximum extent possible, not take place at the same time as meetings of the Third Committee itself. One meeting on 13 October and one meeting on 19 October have been allocated to the Working Group. Subsequent meetings will be announced.

Informal inter-sessional consultations of the Preparatory Committee for the World Summit for Social Development

6. The Committee is further reminded that, at its 16th meeting, on 2 September 1994, the Preparatory Committee for the World Summit for Social Development decided to request its Chairman and Bureau to organize informal inter-sessional consultations during the week of 24 October, in New York, in the framework of the General Assembly. The Third Committee is being requested to suspend its meetings during that week in order to enable the informal inter-sessional consultations to take place with the full participation of all States.

Conclusion of the work of the Committee

7. Bearing in mind the allocation of the number of meetings available to the Third Committee, it is proposed that the Third Committee set a target date of 15 December for the conclusion of its work. In view of the decreased availability of conference services, it is highly unlikely that conference services can be counted on after that date.
