SEIZURE OF 1 KILOGRAMME 220 GRAMMES OF OPIUM
MADE AT ALEXANDRIA ON 5 MAY 1947

Note by the Secretary-General

In accordance with Article 23 of the Convention for limiting the
Manufacture and regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs of
13 July 1931, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the
Secretary-General has the honour to communicate the following report
on the above mentioned seizure to the Members of the United Nations
and to the other parties to the Convention.

SEIZURE OF 1.220 KILOGRAMMES OF OPIUM AT ALEXANDRIA ON MAY 5, 1947,
Ex. S.S. "GEHANGIR".

(Case of KHADR SABRA ABDEL HADI)

At Alexandria, on May 5, 1947 a certain KHADR SABRA ABDEL HADI was searched on suspicion by a Customs Detective while he was landing from S.S. "GEHANGIR". He was found in possession of 2 packets of opium weighing 1.220 kilogrammes, which were concealed under his clothes.

On interrogation he stated that while on board the said steamship a certain person had given him the seized drugs to be smuggled into the City.

On July 20, 1947 the accused was tried by the Drugs Summary Native Court, Alexandria and sentenced to 2 years' imprisonment and a fine of L.E. 300. - (USA \$1239)

The source of origin of the drug seized is unknown.
