15. Remarks: Found concealed with smoking utensils i.e. (2 opium pipes, 1 lamp, 1 pair scales, 1 weight, 1 set of cutting tools and 1 wooden tray) in various articles of furniture, bedding and clothing in the accused's cabin.
16. Legal proceedings penalties: Charged and convicted under section 3, Dangerous Drugs Act 1920 as amended by Dangerous Drugs Act 1925 in respect of the Raw Opium.
Section 5, Dangerous Drugs Act 1920, in respect of the Prepared Opium.
Section 5, Dangerous Drugs Act 1920, in respect of the smoking utensils.

Sentenced to 6 months' imprisonment in respect of each charge.
