15. Remarks: Owing to his bulky appearance, the accused was detailed and searched. The opium was found in various pockets of his clothing. Hong stated that the opium was given to him by a seaman who he believed to be an Indian, but could not identify.
16. Legal proceedings penalties. AH HONG was fined £250 or 12 months imprisonment. Fine not paid - offender committed to prison.
