SEIZURE OF 942 GRAMMES OF HASHISH AT ALEXANDRIA
ON 6 MAY 1946

Note by the Secretary-General

In accordance with Article 23 of the Convention for Limiting the Manufacture and Regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs of 13 July 1931, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to communicate the following report on the above mentioned seizure to the Members of the United Nations and to the other parties to the Convention.

On May 6th, 1946, while ABDEL KADER MUSTAFA MOHAMMED AFIFI and another member of the crew of sailing vessel "Asia" were walking within the port area, they were searched, on suspicion, by a customs official and the former was found hiding two turbas of hashish inside his trousers. On searching the vessel another turba was found hidden in ABDEL KADER's bed.

On 9.7.46 the accused was tried by the Drugs Summary Native Court, Alexandria, and sentenced to 3 years' imprisonment and a fine of L. E. 200.

The source of origin of the seized drug is under inquiry.
