**ON THE ESTABLISHING OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS  
BETWEEN

GUIDED BY THE PRINCIPLES ENUNCIATED IN THE CHARTER OF THE UNITED NATIONS AND BEING DESIROUS TO ESTABLISH RELATIONS OF FRIENDLY AND MUTUALLY BENEFICIAL CO-OPERATION ON THE BASIS OF THE PRINCIPLES OF EQUALITY, NON-INTERFERENCE IN THE INTERNAL AFFAIRS OF THE OTHER, RESPECT FOR INDEPENDENCE AND TERRITORIAL INTEGRITY, THE GOVERNMENT OF THE LAO PEOPLE'S DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC AND THE GOVERNMENT OF PAPUA NEW GUINEA DECIDED TO ESTABLISH DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN THE TWO COUNTRIES AT AMBASSADORIAL LEVEL FROM THE 6 April, 1990.

JOINT COMMUNIQUE ON THE ESTABLISHING OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS  
BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF PAPUA NEW GUINEA AND THE  
GOVERNMENT OF THE LAO PEOPLE'S DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC

Guided by the principles enunciated in the Charter of the United Nations and being desirous to establish relations of friendly and mutually beneficial co-operation on the basis of the principles of equality, non-interference in the internal affairs of the other, respect for independence and territorial integrity, the Government of Papua New Guinea and the Government of the Lao People's Democratic Republic decided to establish diplomatic relations between the two countries at Ambassadorial level from 6 April, 1990.
