APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN SUBSIDIARY ORGANS AND
OTHER APPOINTMENTS: CONFIRMATION OF THE APPOINTMENTS
OF MEMBERS OF THE INVESTMENTS COMMITTEE

Note by the Secretary-General

1. As indicated in document A/49/104 of 18 April 1994, it will be necessary for the General Assembly, during its current session, to confirm the appointment by the Secretary-General of three persons to fill vacancies in the Investments Committee resulting from the expiration on 31 December 1994, of the terms of office of Mr. Ahmad Abdullatif (Saudi Arabia), Mr. Aloysio de Andrade Faria (Brazil) and Mr. Stanislaw Raczkowski (Poland).
2. In accordance with the provisions of article 20 of the Regulations of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund (UNJSPF), the Secretary-General, after consultation with the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Board (UNJSPB) and the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions, submits for confirmation by the General Assembly the reappointment of Mr. Abdullatif, Mr. de Andrade Faria and Mr. Raczkowski, as members of the United Nations Investments Committee for three-year terms of office beginning on 1 January 1995.
3. Mr. Abdullatif has served on the Committee since 1984, Mr. de Andrade Faria since 1976 and Mr. Raczkowski since 1977. The Secretary-General very much appreciates their willingness to carry on this important international public service.
4. The curricula vitae of the appointees for confirmation are set out in the annex to the present document.
5. In accordance with past practice, the Secretary-General has appointed as ad hoc members Mr. Peter Stormonth Darling (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland) and Mr. Alexander P. Papamarkou (United States of America) to serve with the Committee in 1995.
