Insert the following on page 5 before the concluding paragraph:
I suggest that the B.B.C. has been operated with full regard for
the essential principles of availability; that is, its programmes
have reflected all the major viewpoints in British life. And on
the third question I would call attention to the British Government's
statement that "criticism and constructive suggestions from parliament,
the public and the press are desirable."
