AMENDMENTS AND CORRECTIONS TO T/186

1. Page 67, paragraph 194. Under the heading "Alcohol and Spirits" please delete the first three sentences of paragraph 194 and substitute the following:

"The figures appended hereunder represent the quantities of alcoholic and other spirituous beverages sold in licensed stores in the Southern Section of the Territory during 1947:

The Government Senior Boarding Schools at Tamale, and Native Authority Infant-Junior Boarding Schools at Gambaga and Bawku, also serve the northern section of the Territory.

Of the 241 non-assisted schools, 63 have been chosen for "designation". "Designated" schools have been chosen for development by means of grants-in-aid from funds for education administered by Native Authorities. Many other schools which are not aided by the central Government receive small grants from Native Authorities.

3. Page 139. Under the heading "APPENDIX XIII. EDUCATION" "B. Pupils", please delete the paragraph starting from the words, "The population in the Territory of children of school-going age" to the words "of the Territory was 20,095" and substitute the following paragraph, which gives the 1947 figures:

"B. - Pupils"

The population in the Territory of children of school-going age (6 - 15 years) is tentatively estimated at 75,733.
