POLITICAL RIGHTS OF WOMEN

Resolution adopted by the Commission on the
Status of Women

The Commission on the Status of Women,

Having studied the Secretary-General's report on the Collection and Dissemination of Information on Effective Programmes of Political Education for women who have recently acquired the right to vote,

Appreciates the work done by non-governmental organizations in the field of political education,

Notes that effective programmes of such education cannot be undertaken as extensively as desired in certain regions by non-governmental organizations without further assistance; and therefore

Requests the Economic and Social Council to instruct the Secretary-General to make available the information already collected by the Secretariat in the form of a study guide or pamphlet which would assist the organizations working for the political education of women in countries where women have recently acquired the right to vote, or are beginning to participate in public affairs.
