WOMEN IN PUBLIC SERVICES AND FUNCTIONS

On page 5 of document E/CN.6/158/Add.1, under the column "Observations"
for United States of America, in paragraph 5, line 3, in lieu of:

"A 1948 change in the Federal Civil Service Law gives dependent children of female employees survivor's benefits if the husband is dead or divorced. In addition a married woman employed in Federal Civil Service may arrange at her retirement for a reduced annuity to herself and a survivor's benefit for her husband if he survives her."

substitute:

"The Federal Civil Service Retirement law was amended in 1949 to provide the same benefits for survivors of married women as are provided for married male civil service employees. A married female employee may now arrange at the time of retirement for payment of an annuity to her widower upon her death. (63 Fed. Stat. 699)"
