Credentials of the representatives, deputy representatives and alternate representatives of the members of the Security Council elected for the period 2019–2020

Report of the Secretary-General

1. At its 93rd plenary meeting, on 8 June 2018, the General Assembly elected Belgium, the Dominican Republic, Germany, Indonesia and South Africa as non-permanent members of the Security Council for a term of two years beginning on 1 January 2019.
