 Southern Cameroons. Our aim of putting this before you is this;

- I. We ask the United Nations to consider the Southern Cameroons' independent
 as soon as possible.
- II. We ask the United Nations to repeat the Northern Cameroons' Plebiscite,
 which took place on 11th February 1961.
