KAMERUN NATIONAL DEMOCRATIC PARTY AND GOVERNMENT SOUTHERN CAMEROONS WILL NOT REPEAT  
 NOT ACCEPT JOINT PLEBISCITE OF NORTHERN AND SOUTHERN CAMEROONS STOP SOUTHERN  
 CAMEROONS PROBLEM CONSIDERED COMPLETELY CLOSED STOP WILL PRESENT REOPENING  
 BEHIND BACKS OF SOUTHERN CAMEROONS REPRESENTATIVES STOP NORTHERN CAMEROONS NOT  
 YET SUFFICIENTLY STUDIED IN PROBLEMS OF UNIFICATION AS SOUTHERN CAMEROONS WHICH  
 STARTED DOING THIS 1951 STOP CONSIDER IT IMMORAL AND UNFAIR TO ASK NORTHERN  
 CAMEROONS TAKE DECISION AT SAME TIME WITH SOUTHERN CAMEROONS STOP ADVOCATE THAT  
 NORTHERN CAMEROONS TAKE DECISION AFTER RESULTS SOUTHERN CAMEROONS PLEBISCITE ARE  
 KNOWN AND THAT ONE OF THE QUESTIONS THEN BE THEIR JOINING SOUTHERN CAMEROONS STOP
