ORGANIZATION OF WORK

List of issues

(Submitted by the delegation of Peru)

1. Identification of straddling fish stocks and highly migratory fish stocks whose fishing may require review by the Conference.
2. Identification of the principal ocean areas in which such species exist.
3. Definition of the general obligations of States in the light of the provisions of the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea and other relevant instruments.
4. Scope of cooperation and functions of the competent international organizations at the global, regional and subregional levels.
5. Collection of scientific, technological and statistical data on resources, environmental factors, fishing fleets, fishing methods, intensity of fishing activity, transshipment operations, marketing of fishery products and other related topics.
6. Scientific research and technology transfers.
7. Measures for the conservation and sound management of resources (maximum catch allowable, optimum sustainable yield, quotas, open and closed fishing seasons, minimum sizes, fishing techniques and equipment, conservation of the marine environment, incidental catch, declaration of overfishing, etc.).

8. Registration of fishing vessels.
9. Flagging of fishing vessels.
10. Registration of fishing activity on a regional or subregional basis.
11. Monitoring and verification systems (maritime, land, air, satellite, on-board observers and inspections, etc.).
12. Assistance to developing countries.
13. Implementation procedures.
14. Sanctions.
15. States other than States parties.
16. Settlement of disputes.
17. Other matters (e.g. access of States that have not previously fished the high seas).
