1. Page 8

Paragraph 19 should read

19. In paragraph 10 of resolution 47/210, the General Assembly invited Member States to make voluntary contributions to UNPROFOR both in cash and in the form of services and supplies acceptable to the Secretary-General. For the period from 15 October 1992 to 30 April 1993, voluntary contributions received by UNPROFOR, as valued by the donor Governments, consisted of:

(a) A cash contribution of Sw F 10,000 (equivalent to \$7,081) from the Government of the Principality of Liechtenstein;

(b) The loan of 15 armoured personnel carriers, with full equipment, commencing from February 1993 from the Government of Italy and valued at Lit 8,250,000,000 (equivalent to \$5,593,220) for this period;

(c) The donation of two armoured personnel carriers from the Government of Switzerland valued at Sw F 620,000 (equivalent to \$433,566);

(d) The donation of two sedans from the Government of Sweden valued at SKr 284,000 (equivalent to \$42,388);

(e) The donation of 3,400 operational maps from the United States of America valued at \$1,700,000.

Additionally, air ambulance service for the repatriation of those wounded or taken ill in the performance of their duties as and when required was made available to UNPROFOR by the Government of Switzerland. This service was utilized to evacuate one Field Service staff member from Zagreb to Dublin in April 1993.
