REFERENCE TO RESPONSIBILITY FOR ATTACKS ON SUCH PERSONNEL

Proposal by Thailand

States Parties undertake to establish their jurisdiction over the crimes committed in the host or transit State by the personnel that they have assigned to participate in a United Nations operation and to submit the alleged offenders to their competent authorities for the purpose of prosecution upon request of the States in which the crimes were committed, in the cases where the immunity of the alleged offenders was not waived.
