The Chargé d'affaires a.i. of the Permanent Observer Mission of Switzerland to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to refer to his note SCPC/2/93(11-1) of 22 September 1993, and in particular to paragraph 24 of Security Council resolution 864 (1993).

On behalf of the Swiss authorities, the Chargé d'affaires has the honour to reply to the request of the Secretary-General as follows:

Independently of the embargo declared against UNITA on 15 September 1993, Switzerland, in accordance with the Federal War Equipment Act of 1972, does not export arms to Angola. Furthermore, Switzerland does not import petroleum from Angola, any more than it exports it.
