SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF  
WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE STAGE  
REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in documents S/1995/40 of 16 January 1995 and S/1995/40/Add.2 of 25 January 1995.

During the week ending 1 April 1995, the Security Council took action on the following items:

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3512th meeting, held on 31 March 1995, in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the report of the Secretary-General pursuant to Security Council resolution 947 (1994) (S/1995/222 and Corr.1). There was one suspension and one resumption of the meeting.

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia and the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President drew attention to the text of three draft resolutions (S/1995/242, S/1995/243 and S/1995/244), all of which had been submitted by Argentina, the Czech Republic, France, Germany, Italy, the Russian Federation, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the United States of America.

Upon the resumption of the meeting, on the same date, the Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/1995/242 and adopted it unanimously as resolution 981 (1995) (for the text, see S/RES/981 (1995); to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Fiftieth Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1995).

The Security Council then proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/1995/243 and adopted it unanimously as resolution 982 (1995) (for the text, see S/RES/982 (1995); to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Fiftieth Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1995).
